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Upcoming ANHIX Events

The Spring Symposium and AGM will be held in Edmonton on **May 17, 2017** at the Holiday Inn, South Edmonton.

The Summer Symposium/Golf Tournament will be held on **September 13, 2017**. Once again, it will be held at the Ranch Golf and Country Club at Acheson.

The 5th annual ANHIX-COACH conference was held in Calgary on February 8. The theme was **Integrated Health Records – Improving Patient Care for Albertans**. Over 140 were in attendance.

The opening speaker was Barb Kathol, Senior Program Officer, AHS. Barb talked to the vision for integrated health records in Alberta. She described the purpose of the provincial CIS and spoke to the roles various stakeholders will play in its implementation.

Barb was followed by Kathleen Addison, Senior Provincial Director, HIM, who spoke to AHS' Enterprise Information Management Governance

Framework. The framework is a key construct in supporting AHS' progression towards an enterprise information management program. She outlined the purpose, goals, progress and outcomes of the framework, focusing on its alignment to the CIS.

Prof. Tania Bubela, School of Public Health, University of Alberta, then spoke to precision medicine. Precision medicine is becoming a key part of the new information frontier for healthcare delivery but it will not happen quickly. The transition will require careful guidance by a consortium of academia, healthcare, government and solution providers

along with patients and the public.

After lunch, Dr. Rob Hayward, CMIO, AHS, spoke to Better Information for Better Health – Bridging the Disconnect. Believing that better information is a necessary but not sufficient condition for better healthcare, Dr. Hayward explored how patient information provided by a CIS will be managed, presented and applied so that health practices change and health outcomes improve.

Dr. Hayward was followed by Mark Casselman, CEO, COACH. Mark presented key findings from the first COACH National Digital Health Leadership Report. The report captures an overview of key priorities, challenges and opportunities in the field of health informatics.

The conference concluded with a panel session with Kathleen Addison, Rob Hayward, Mark Casselman and Kevin Jones and moderated by Penny Rae, CIO, AHS. The panel focused on the work required to ensure a sound foundation for integrated health records.
