## BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Jeremy Theal is the Chief Medical Information Officer (CMIO) at Alberta Health Services in Alberta, Canada.

In this role, he is the lead physician for implementation and continuous improvement of a province-wide clinical information system serving 4.5 million citizens across over 800 facilities and over 8,900 acute care beds, the largest project of its kind in North America. He also practices Gastroenterology at the University of Alberta Hospital, where he is an Associate Clinical Professor of Medicine.

Prior to his work in Alberta, he was the CMIO at North York General Hospital in Toronto, Canada. During his 15 years in Ontario, he led many digital health initiatives at local, regional, provincial, and national scale, several of which were award-winning.

As a recognized expert in improving patient and provider outcomes through the use of clinical information systems, Dr. Theal has engaged with clinicians, administrators and policy makers in 12 different countries and has served as an advisor to over 100 hospitals, both in Canada and internationally.
